A watching brief was carried out on groundworks associated with the alterations and extensions of the hotel. Background evidence for some form of Romano-British occupation in the late 3rd century AD was recorded, as well as evidence for Saxo-Norman activity in the form of a domestic rubbish pit, subsequently re-cut in the Medieval Period.
