No archaeological sites or findspots are recorded within the study area. However, Clapham Road lies on or near the line of a Roman Road known as Stane Street. The site therefore has the potential to contain deposits associated with the road or roadside structures of Roman date. In the medieval period and up to 18th century the site may have been agricultural land associated with the village of Stockwell. However, with the rise in demand for housing in the 19th century the Clapham Road frontages were gradually built upon. Indeed, this architectural heritage is reflected by the fact that the study area lies within the Stockwell Park Conservation Area. [Au(abr)] *SMR primary record number:* 22/253
