The site was found to lay close to the Camber [medieval harbour], although maps show that it was developed mostly in the post-medieval period. Medieval and post-medieval finds have been recovered in the area, especially related to industrial archaeology. Prehistoric, Iron Age and Roman finds have also been recorded, although their exact location was unknown. [Au(abr)]

The majority of the site lay over the infilled millpond, which was drained and backfilled from 1876. The potential for the survival of archaeological remains here was thought to be low. At the southern end of the development area, it was predicted that the buried stone remains of the mid-17th century defences would be recovered. The northern area of the site was thought to preserve some 18th and 19th century buildings. [Au(adp)]
