A geophysical survey was undertaken on land at the Langley Park School for Boys. The site was being used as a sports field for the school. Existing sports equipment [e.g. Rugby goalposts], service/drain covers and boundaries caused some distortion to the dataset, however, the survey revealed a number of anomalies, the majority of which could be attributed to known boundaries and features, as shown on historical maps and aerial photographs. These included a former track, the remains of a demolished nursery, and former boundaries. Two curvilinear anomalies may have been of archaeological significance as they did not appear on any known mapping and did not conform to existing or known former boundaries. There were many dipolar responses which were likely to have been caused by modern ferrous detritus. [Au(abr)]
