Report on an Archaeological Evaluation Carried out on Land at the Rear of 328 Brixton Road, Brixton, SW9, in the London Borough of Lambeth in July 2002

An L-shaped trench had already been dug by the site owner to discourage squatters and it was agreed that this was to be used as the archaeological evaluation trench. A sherd of Roman pottery was overlain by a post-medieval 'ploughsoil' which contained one fragment of residual Roman tile and another of Roman pottery as well as a small assemblage of common post-medieval pottery.
