The archaeological programme consisted of six separate archaeological investigations set out in order to answer specific questions pertaining to structures and features within the Down House dating to the period of Darwin's occupation using targeted trenches. A series of 19th century paths were identified in the orchard area of the gardens. The foundation trench of a 19th century tool shed was also located, as was the post socket for the net post of the tennis court. The Kitchen Garden Wall and a shed in the Service Yard were also recorded. [Au(adp)]
