Within area 1, two pits were identified in trench 4 cutting the natural subsoil. The only finds from the area were unstratified post-medieval pottery. Ridge and furrow cultivation was identified in three of the trenches excavated in area 2. The only finds recovered from the area were unstratified post-medieval pottery. In area 3 modern dumping layers of industrial fuel waste were identified within trench 2. no finds or other archaeological features were seen. An earthworks survey of the extant ridge and furrow was undertaken in area 2. [Au(abr)]
