Archaeological features existed on the north, north-east and south-west of the redevelopment site. The features were all post-medieval dating from the 19th to 20th century and consisted of two wells, four rubbish pits, and a wall footing. These remains represent backyard cut features probably associated with the post-medieval houses that previously occupied the site. Three soakaways and associated drainage ditch were probably associated with the former printing works that also previously occupied the site. [Au(adp)]
