The earthwork was surveyed and interpreted after a short desk-based assessment. The earthwork was omitted from early OS maps, suggesting that it was constructed in the last 100 years. However, references in Saxon documents may show an 11th century origin. Possible uses for the earthwork were suggested as a rabbit warren or header pond for a mill, of which two were recorded in the Domesday book. However, the authors concluded that the most likely function was for stock control. [Au(adp)]
