The gradiometer data are dominated by parallel linear anomalies on a southwest-northeast alignment. These appear to respect a northwest-southeast response in the west of the survey area. It is equally likely that they indicate drainage ditches associated with a sewage system known to exist in the survey area. A rectilinear system of low resistance anomalies dominate the resistance area. [Au(abr)]
