The 10 meter topsoil magnetic susceptibility mapping showed that the topsoil had a dynamic magnetic range, and identified relatively strong patterning at a number of locations. Despite this evidence, follow-up magnetometer (gradiometer) survey (2.7ha) revealed only the most ephemeral anomalies at variance with otherwise well defined linear magnetic anomalies which are products of the current agricultural landscape, and there is consequently little magnetometer evidence to suggest extensive underlying archaeological activity.
