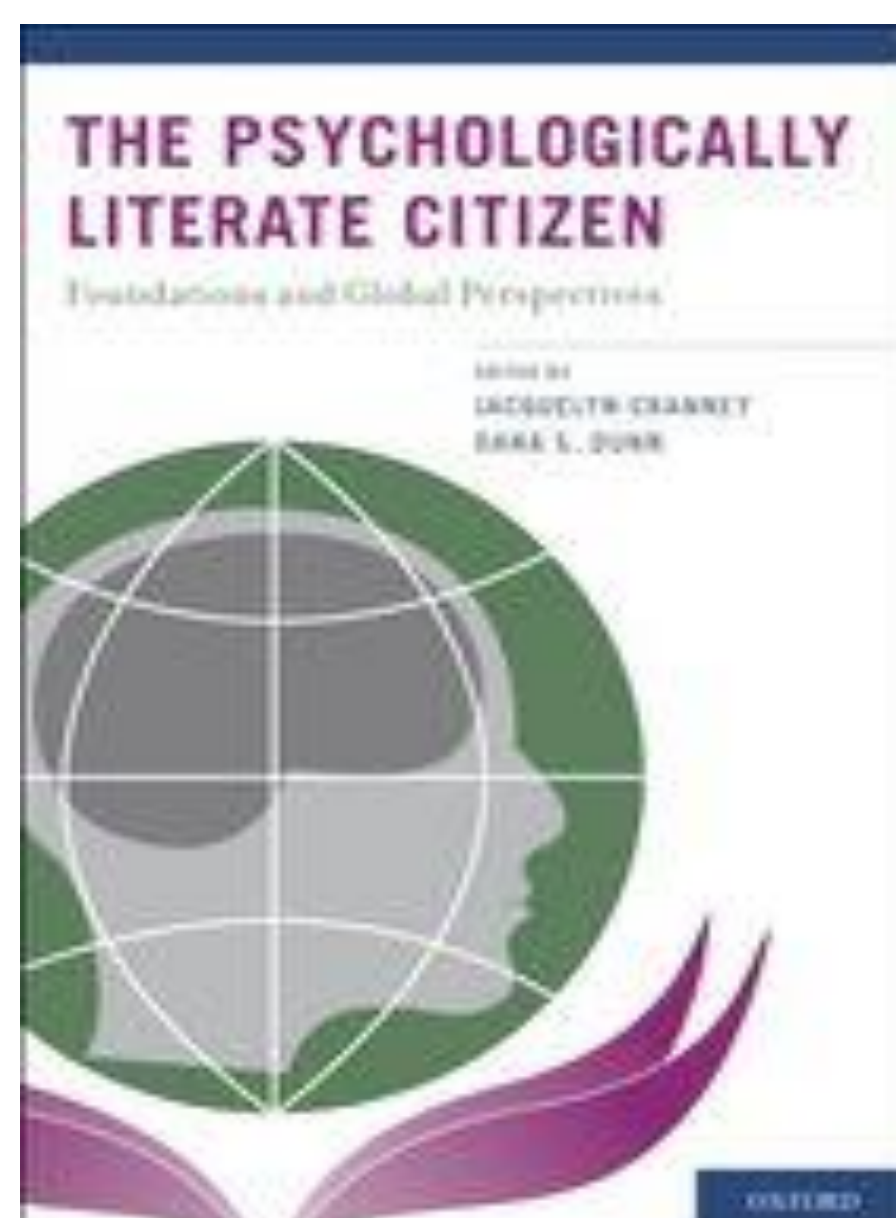
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The Problem

The Solution

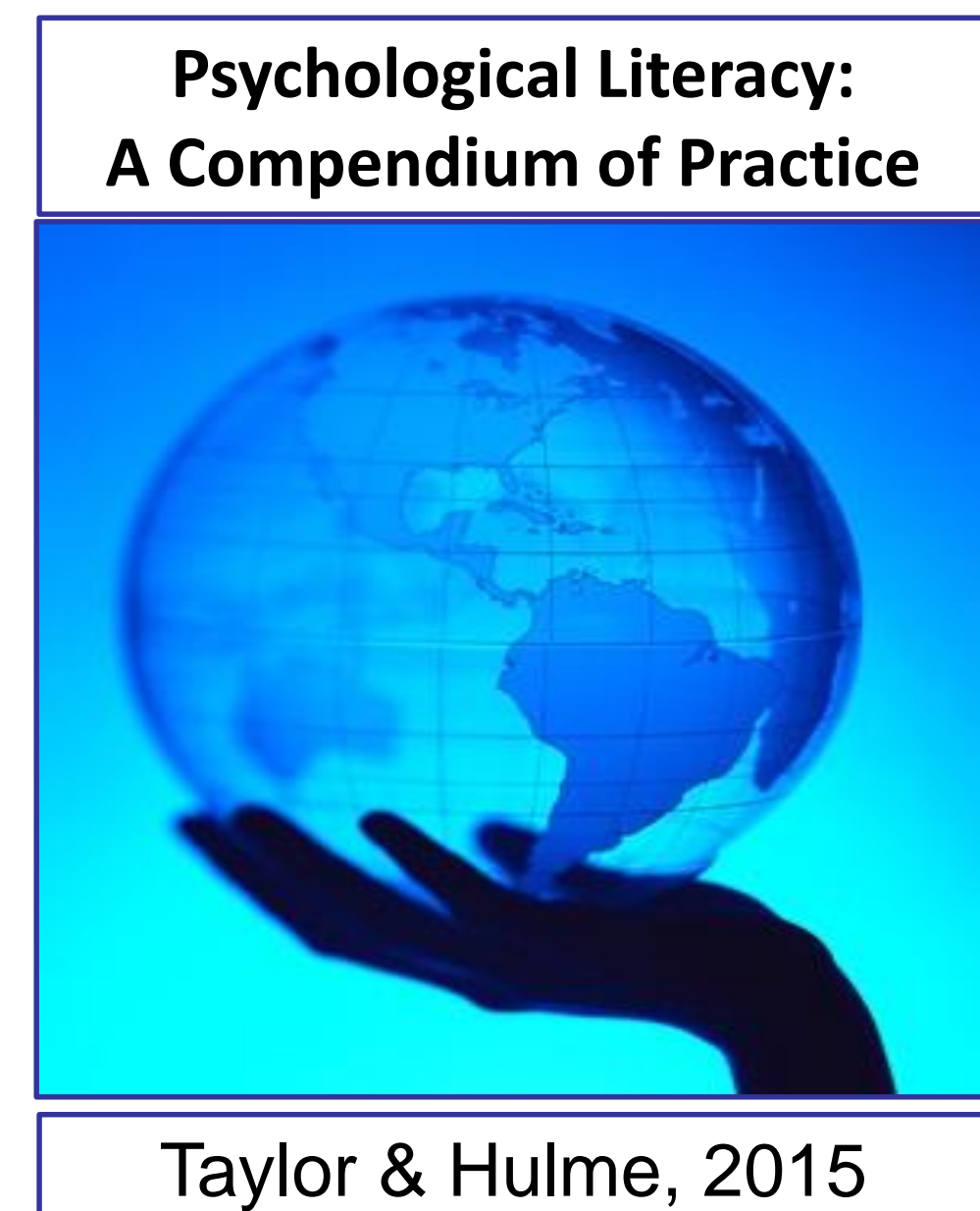
Invited case studies from Psychology learning and teaching community

...but how can we design and assess activities?

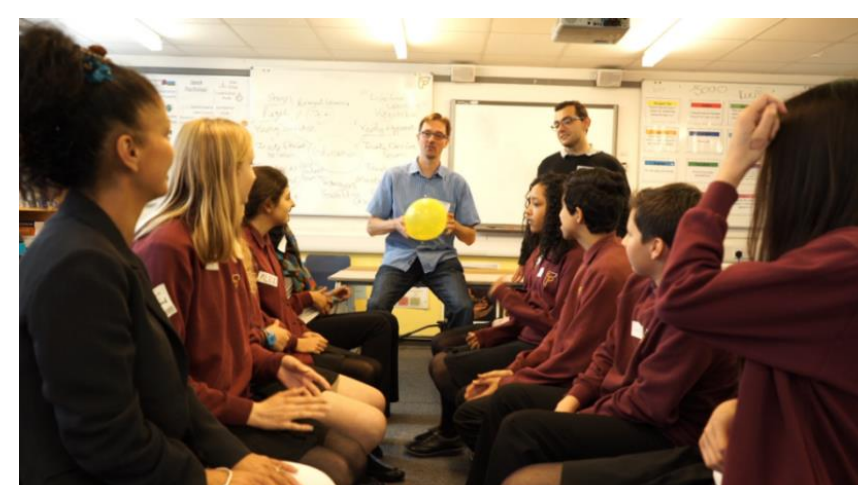
Case Studies were categorised to allow easy comparison of different approaches for academics and teachers



Evaluated each case study in terms of the nine psychological attributes identified by McGovern et al. (2010)

Categorised: area of psychology, level, whether core / optional, activity and assessment strategies
